Call for papers

We invite authors to submit manuscripts from different disciplinary perspectives, as we believe that the Journal's themes can be elaborated and researched from multiple theoretical and methodological perspectives.

Issues of the journal are divided into three sections:

- “Articles” – research and scholarship, and insights from practice;
- “Forum” – conversations engaging diverse points of view on topics of interest;
- “Critique” – review essays on practice and shorter reviews of books and media.

Trilingual Journal:

Our University invites writers to publish in English, Hebrew or Spanish.

Paper format:

We are looking for papers with a preferred length of 4,000 words (suggested length for practitioners, activists, and policy makers' papers), and up to 7,000 words (for academic papers).

The articles should be submitted in word format, double spaced, David font size 12. References APA style. (For the use of other referencing styles, please contact the Journal editors).

Each article should have a cover letter, with the author's details, a statement on the importance/relevance of the article, plus a title, abstract and up to five key words. The letter should also mention which section of the journal the manuscript is submitted for.
